

RULES OF THE ROAD, IBEW LOCAL UNION 993

- Disciplinary Action in another Jurisdiction or an Official complaint from another local could result in travelling privileges being revoked for said member.
- Always carry your paid-up dues receipt with you while travelling.
- Always carry your clearance for the job and travel letter where applicable from your Local Union.
- You must follow the terms of the Local Unions agreement where you are working as a traveller.
- Remember, you are a guest, and you are a representative of your Local Union, ensure your actions, and work ethic reflect well on your Local Union.
- Do not accept Supervisory positions, such as a chargehand or general chargehand, unless all Local Members in that Jurisdiction have been offered the opportunity first.
- Avoid involvement in the politics of another Local Union, keep your opinions to yourself.
- Never accept a transfer while working outside of your Jurisdiction without checking in with the Local Union beforehand.
- Conduct yourself with the professionalism expected of an IBEW Union Member.
